



Garage Door Opener



1 While the car is ON, hold the handheld garage door transmitter 1-3 inches from the HomeLink® button you want to program in the vehicle.

2 Push and hold both the HomeLink® button being programmed and the button on the garage door transmitter.

TO ERASE ALL SET CHANNELS:

Push and hold the two outside HomeLink® buttons for 20 seconds until the orange indicator flashes. An individual channel cannot be erased.



ROLLING OR NON-ROLLING?

Check your garage door opener motor in your garage for a “LEARN” or “TRAIN” button by the hanging antenna. If you have one of these, you have a Rolling Code garage door opener.

For Non-Rolling Code garage door openers, watch for the indicator light to go constant.

For Rolling Code garage door openers, watch for the indicator light to go from a slow blink to blinking rapidly.

For Rolling Code garage door openers only, firmly push and release the “LEARN” or “TRAIN” button on your garage door opener motor in your garage, then push the HomeLink® button in your vehicle three times (holding the button for two seconds each time).

If the programming was successful, your garage door should open and close with your chosen HomeLink® button.

Pair a Phone



- 1** Make sure Bluetooth® is enabled on your mobile device
- 2** With the vehicle in the ACC or ON/RUN position, press the Phone button on the vehicle's touchscreen menu bar
- 3** Press "Device Manager"
- 4** Select "Add Device"
- 5** Follow the prompts on your phone and on the touchscreen

Troubleshooting

- 1** Perform a reset by holding the power button on the radio for 15 seconds
- 2** Reboot your phone
- 3** Remove the paired phone
- 4** Follow the Pair a Phone steps above to set up phone

CONNECT YOUR APPS

Connect your smartphone to the media USB port or pair your smartphone within "Device Manager".

The Android Auto™ or Apple CarPlay® icon will replace the phone icon on the touchscreen.

KEEP IN MIND:



For Android™ Users, if the Android Auto™ app was not previously downloaded, it will download the first time you plug in your device.



For Apple® Users, Apple CarPlay® is only compatible with iPhone® 5 or later and requires Siri being enabled in "Settings".

Ready to remove a phone or audio device?

- 1** Press the Device Manager button on the touchscreen.
- 2** Press the Settings gear icon next to the phone or device you wish to remove.
- 3** Press "Delete Device". The device should be removed.
- 4** On your phone's Bluetooth® or Set Up menu, remove the saved Uconnect radio.

Voice Recognition

USE YOUR VOICE TO CONTROL UCONNECT

If your Uconnect system is equipped with Navigation, you have access to built-in Voice Recognition. If your Uconnect system is not equipped with Navigation, refer to the following Android Auto™ or Apple CarPlay® instructions.

- 1 Push the Voice Recognition button or say the Uconnect “Wake Up” word to begin. The “Wake Up” word is customizable within Vehicle settings. You can set it to “Hey, Uconnect” or “Hey, Ram”.
- 2 After the beep, say a command. Below are a few examples:
 - “Call <phone contact>.”
 - “Change Source to FM.”
 - “Call 123-456-7891.”
 - “Navigate to <desired location>.”
 - “Tune to 95.5.”

Using Android Auto™ Or Apple CarPlay®?

You can use Voice Recognition with Android Auto™ and Apple CarPlay®!

Activate Android Auto™ or Apple CarPlay® from “Device Manager” in Phone Mode. The respective icon will replace the Phone icon in the menu bar.

CUSTOMIZE THE INSTRUMENT CLUSTER DISPLAY

- 1** Select "Settings" with the Up or Down Arrow button on the steering wheel.
- 2** Select "HUD" with the Right or Left Arrow button on the steering wheel. Press "OK".
- 3** Adjust available Settings like Content & Layout, Display Height, and Brightness. Press "OK" to change the setting.

Display On Windshield




TIP:

Select "Custom" and begin customizing your Cluster layout from the Uconnect system.


Pick a display layout of two, three, four, or five icons. Drag and drop the icons to the provided zones on the touchscreen!




Displays vehicle speed.




Displays Driver Assist, Cruise Control, Adaptive Cruise Control, and LaneSense information.

View the status of your Off-Road Pages like Transfer Case, Pitch and Roll, and Accessory Gauges. You can also access the Forward Facing Camera.


